

Plan International UK TCS London Marathon 2024

Golden Bond Application Terms and Conditions

Important - please read these Terms and Conditions.

General Terms:

- Should my application be successful, I agree to Plan International UK passing my name and email address to the event organiser as is necessary for the sole purpose of completing the registration of my place in the TCS London Marathon 2024.
- If my application is successful, Plan International UK will be in touch to collect my deposit of £100.
- In order to apply for a Golden Bond place, I have completed an application form and agreed to these terms and conditions.
- Should my application be successful I pledge to raise a *minimum* of £2,000 sponsorship (in addition to my deposit of £100 and exclusive of Gift Aid) through my own sponsorship generating activities. I will pay this amount to Plan International UK by cheque, credit card or via Enthuse or JustGiving *no later than 2 June 2024*.
- We expect you to raise at least £500 by 31 January 2024. If you do not reach this target, and do not have an adequate fundraising plan in place, Plan International UK has the right to revoke your place.
- If I need more time to collect personal sponsorship pledged by others I will let Plan International UK know in writing, in advance of 21 April 2024, so any necessary arrangements can be made.
- If I am not able to fundraise the minimum amount of £2000, I understand that I am to cover the outstanding amount myself.
- Any fundraising materials that I may produce of my own accord **must** include the phrase “**Plan International UK is a charity registered in England and Wales No 276035**”
- Please note that photographs may be taken at this event. As we use real images such as these to gain support for our work to help advance children’s rights and equality for girls, we may use your image in promotional and communication materials (in print and online). We’ll also share the photos with all Team Plan participants after the event. If you’d prefer that we didn’t use or share your image, please let us know by emailing CommunityFundraising@plan-uk.org.
- I am or will at least be 18 years of age on the date of the Marathon (21 April 2024).
- I acknowledge that I am taking part in this event at my own risk. I therefore do not hold Plan International UK or any of its representatives responsible for any injury or loss that might occur as a result of my participation.

Golden Bond withdrawal including injury:

- If I sustain a training injury, I will contact Plan International UK immediately to review the situation as I realise the importance of being completely fit to participate in the Marathon.
- If I choose to withdraw from the TCS London Marathon 2024 through injury or any other reason, I will let Plan International UK know immediately to give the opportunity for another runner to take up the Golden Bond place.
- If I need to withdraw my accepted entry, I will inform Plan International UK in writing and advise all my sponsors of my withdrawal.
- If I do not take part in the event, any sponsorship money raised will be treated as donations unless your sponsors contact Plan International UK directly for a refund.
- I will repay any sponsorship I have collected personally and which has not been passed to Plan International UK, to my sponsors directly within 30 days of my withdrawal.
